Personal protective equipment (PPE) Access and exit protocols

INTRODUCTION

Biological risk: The biological agents to which the personnel working in the necropsy room can be exposed, are those included in ANNEX II of Royal Decree 664/1997.

Chemical Risk: Formaldehyde (formalin). Risk during collection and sample processing for technical personnel and eventually for teaching staff, researchers and students.

Performing necropsies

ENTRY

- 1. CHANGING ROOM: Students must wear
 - Disposable overall
 - Disposable gloves
 - Face mask
 - Safety glasses
 - Anti-cut glove (usually left-handed)
 - Safety boots
 - Disposable boots cover

2. CORRIDOR:

Waterproof apron (provided by the faculty)

EXIT

- 1. NECROPSY ROOM: Discard disposable gloves, mask and boot covers. Clean rubber boots and apron with soap and water
- 2. CORRIDOR: Leave the cleaned apron in the area indicated
- 3. CHANCHING ROOM: Discard remaining plastic protective material

Attending diagnosis only

ENTRY

- **CHANGING ROOM: Students must wear**
 - Disposable overall
 - Face mask
 - Safety glasses
 - Disposable plastic cover (over shoes or boots)

EXIT

- 1. NECROPSY ROOM: Discard mask and shoe/boot cover
- 2. CORRIDOR: Discard plastic coat
